On Tuesday, January 12, 2010, an earthquake of a magnitude of 7.0 hit approximately 16 miles west of Haiti's capital. It has been estimated that 3,000,000 people have been affected by the quake, leaving 200,000 people dead, 300,000 people injured, and 1,000,000 people homeless.

With the buildings, homes, and lives destroyed, Haiti is in need of help now more than ever. SACNAS (Society for the Advancement of Chicanos and Native Americans in Science) along with MESA (Mathematics, Engineering, and Science Achievement) and many other local organizations and clubs have partnered to hold an event for the Haiti relief effort that will include:
