- 4. Coordinator's report and discussion items
 - a. Status report for Applied Technology and Business programs. Coordinator noted that several reports are near completion and ready to be submitted for dean review. Two AT&B programs were completed in 2017 after delays: Computer Information and Mechatronics. The committee agreed that these two programs should be addressed in the two-year abridged review (in 2020), but that a six-year review at this point would be redundant.
 - b. Form to pay adjuncts for PR work. Committee reviewed a draft of the updated form; coordinator will meet with VPAA to ensure the new form will be workable.
 - c. Program Review module mockup discussion. Committee members reviewed and discussed the module components, noting areas of technical concern and suggesting revisions to content. - ii. Time frame: "short term" (within the current academic year) or "long term" (beyond the current academic year)
- iii. Source for funds: "internal" (Dean-level, using department-level funds allocated to Schools) or "external" (Institutional-level, using funds beyond the School)
