Goals for Academic Program Review 2015-2016

Fall 2015

- 1. Make changes to membership and to operating procedures to be Brown Act compliant
- 2. Review discipline program review self-studies and provide feedback as they are completed by discipline faculty
- 3. Create a "style sheet" to add to the handbook and distribute to faculty undergoing review
- 4. Provide support and training to those undergoing the program review process (faculty, deans, etc.)
- 5. Provide additional means of analyzing data to be more flexible to programmatic needs
- 6. Undergo self-assessment of the Academic Program Review Committee
- 7. Determine how 2 year abridged program reviews for CTE programs integrate with the Academic Program Review committee and its processes
- 8. Ensure the Academic Program Review website is up-to-date
- 9. Support in the development of processes that link program review recommendations with institutional short and long-term planning
- 10. Work with Academic Senate to ensure the mission and membership of the committee are accurately reflected in the Senate by-laws.

Spring 2016

In addition to the above:

Develop an assessment to be given to stakeholders (faculty and administration) about the program review process to use to revise the Academic Program Review template and handbook as part of a continued cycle of subcommittee improvement
