"Vision for Future Solano College Athletics Expansion" - Erik Visser

Athletic Director Erik Visser presented an overview of the college's sports offerings and included information on the logistics involved (Title 9, curriculum, funding, etc.) with adding new sports to our lineup: Men's Soccer and Women's Beach Volleyball.

Renaming Correctional Education Program - Tony Zitko

Dean Zitko <u>proposed</u> changing the program name to: Solano Community College Rising Scholars. Item was moved to action items and then Senate voted (by acclamation) approval to support this name change.

Senate Representation for the Correctional Program (SCC Rising Scholars) – Tony Zitko & LaNae Jaimez

The (larger) Rising Scholars program asks about program representation at the local Senate

level. This ties in to Senate conversations earlier this year regarding how to provide representation to programs and areas that do not have a Senator seat and whether this role could be filled by At-Large senator seats or additional seats. Tony Zitko will report to senate until we determine a liaison from current Senators that have worked with our incarcerated population.
