

Chromebook Lending Service

For currently enrolled students who are lacking a computer or laptop to successfully complete their classes, the Chromebook Lending Service is here to help! *Chromebooks can be checked out for one semester at a time, with a possibility of renewing the loan for following semesters.

To be eligible for the Chromebook Lending Service, students must:

- *Be enrolled for 3 or more units at Solano College,*
- *Display a need for technology resources that would prevent the successful completion of online, in-person or hybrid classes,*
- *Agree to maintain the condition of the Chromebook as received in,*
- *Agree to return the Chromebook to SCC according to the dates and times provided.*

If you think you may be eligible for this lending service, please follow the below link to submit your request form. **Once processed, approved students will receive a confirmation email from Academic.Support@solano.edu with the dates and times of upcoming check-out sessions.

IMPORTANT

Failure to return a checked-out Chromebook will result in a hold being placed on your Student Account. Chromebook loans may be renewed by submitting the applicable request form for the next semester, and this must be done prior to the return deadline. Only students who are enrolled for the semester they are requesting a renewal for will be approved.

Chromebook Renewal

Students who would like to request a renewal of their Chromebook loan for an upcoming semester may submit the new request form and mark “Yes” to the question “Is this a request to renew your Chromebook loan from the (*current semester*) to the (*next semester*).” Students must have verified enrollment for the semester the renewal is requested for. Submission of the form does not guarantee approval. An approval email will be received from Academic.Support@solano.edu.
