Evidence:

In February of 2015, a prerequisite of HS 51 to HS 54 was approved based on R&P data that supported classroom experience. Reviewing data provided in Table 1 (over the past 4 years), we find that when students first take HS 51 Introduction to Human Services before HS 54 Group Process, they earn:

- ✓ 18.15% more As
- ✓ 6.4 % more Bs
- ✓ 9.56% less Cs
- ✓ 6.64% less Fs
- ✓ 9.34% less Ws
