Self-Assessment

- To what degree has the committee met its roles and responsibilities?
-AY 2016-17 was the first year of a new approach/process for the PDFC committee. The committee did a good job of creating and implementing the Flexible Calendar schedule. In addition, the committee worked to refine the processing of award faculty professional development funds. Furthermore, the committee assessed the needs of the campus community and used the data to develop the Fall 2018 Flex Cal schedule.
- How can the committee improve its effectiveness in meeting these roles and responsibilities?
-There is no release time for a PDFC chair or coordinator. The basic roles and responsibilities consume all of the committees' time which allows little time for the development/implementation of other initiatives.

- How effective was the committee in completing its initiatives?
-We completed most of our initiatives or they are in process. The initiatives where there was no progress were due to the fact that committee members did not have time to commit to additional project/activities.
- How might the committee improve its effectiveness in regard to completing initiatives?
-Allocation of release time for a PDFC coordinator.
- How effective was the committee in impacting student success?
-It is difficult to directly measure the impact of the PDFC committee's activities on student success; however, the committee offered more than 50 different optional flex professional development events and sponsored 45 individual faculty professional development activities. Many, if not most, of the activities directly or indirectly impact student success.
- How might the committee improve its effectiveness in regard to impacting student success?
-The campus community indicated (via survey) that they would like professional development activities that help them develop specific skills, abilities and tools for working with students. The PDFC committee is committed to providing such trainings in AY 17-18.
- What resources are needed to assist the committee in meeting its initiatives?
-The PDFC committee has a budget that meets its needs and support from the S-P of SCC. The greatest needs of the committee are a funded coordinator position and a dynamic website.
