

TYPING TEST CERTIFICATES – SPRING 2017

You can take a typing test and receive a certificate immediately at the Solano Community College Main Campus in Fairfield.

The 5-minute typing test is given in Room 502 on Fridays from 10:30am-3:30pm on the following dates:

April 7, 21 & 28 • May 5 & 12

√There is no fee for the test, you just need to bring your photo ID
√Typing Certificate will show your words per minute/how many errors,
and is signed by a proctor.

You must already have completed the application process for the college.
