Notice to Students Parking on Solano College Campuses

If you haven't already done so, now is the time to purchase your semester parking permit online through MySolano. To purchase your parking permit:

- 1. Log into your student account on MySolano
- 2. Click on "Student Parking", located on the bottom right-hand side underneath the "Parking" header

Be sure to have a printer available at the time you make your purchase in order to print the temporary permit you'll need to use until your decal arrives in the mail. Purchasing a decal now for \$20 will eliminate your need to worry about having a permit for the entire semester. Alternatively, you can use the daily parking permit dispensers located on the perimeter of each campus parking lot.

Parking permits are refundable if you drop all of your class/ es and the parking permit is returned to the Campus Sheriff's Office (Building 1800B, across from the tennis courts on the Fairfield campus) no later than the refund deadline of your class/es.
