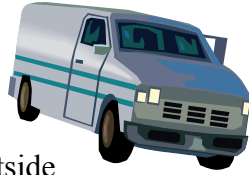

MRI & TATTOOS:

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) is a type that uses the characteristic behavior of protons (& other atomic nuclei) when placed in powerful magnetic fields to make images of tissues & organs. People may have swelling or burning in the tattoo when they have MRI's. This can occur when the MRI interacts with the molecules in the tattoo pigments/inks. Although, this happens rarely & does not last very long, there is a possibility that the procedure will need to be interrupted or terminated. The interaction between tattoo pigments (especially iron oxide-based inks) and the MRI can potentially alter the quality of the MRI results. Some chemical substances which may be used in tattooing & their colors of pigmentation are:



Black, Camel yellow & Light Brown: iron oxide.

White: titanium dioxide;

Red: cinnabar, mercuric sulfate (cadmium sulfide added makes red brighter); **Yellow:** cadmium sulfide.
