

ASSC MINUTES
Nov. 3, 2015

- I. The meeting was called to order at 12:31pm.
- II. Official Roll Call. All senators were present.
- III. Matt Hartsock moved to approve the agenda, the motion was seconded, and was passed unanimously.
- IV. Approval of Minutes
 - A. Zach Freeman moved to approve the minutes for October 20th, the motion was seconded, and was passed unanimously.

 - A.
