1. eLumen Presentation

a. eLumen representatives gave an overview of the assessment functionality of eLumen. They talked about the training and support they provide, how it links to banner and "talks" to the curriculum side. Faculty have a window of time to assess their courses and assessments can be individualized per student. There is integration with CANVAS, and the interface can be personalized (somewhat) to work similar to our current system. Completed faculty assessments in CurricUNET would not be able to be brought over. Like in META, the SLO assessments feed into program learning outcome assessments, and changes to the course outline of record automatically feed into the course outline of record. The interface is user friendly and planned actions can be linked to "projects" that the faculty hope to initiate. This can be part of the integrated planning process, and data can feed into program review. Reports seem to be easy to generate. Many California Community Colleges have switched to eLumen. The assessment committee will discuss the pros and cons of the switch at our meeting in January and will formulate a recommendation. The primary concern is related to faculty having to be retrained to a new system and potentially wasted time/effort completing assessments in CurricUNET META that may now be unusable.
