1. **Call to order** – Josh Scott & Lisa Neeley
2. **Comments from the public.**
3. **Update from Dr. Shannon Cooper, Vice President of Student Services and Dr. Celia Esposito-Noy, Superintendent/President.** S/P Esposito-Noy announced a new Equity Council at convocation on August 15<sup>th</sup>, and Dr. Cooper presented a proposed redesign of Student Services to the Board on August 26<sup>th</sup>. They will both share their respective visions, and we will also have a chance to formally welcome Dr. Cooper, as our new Vice President of Student Services. We also will hopefully have a chance to learn more about the state of our Support and Equity programs, including which are still in operation and which are suspended.
4. **Identify focus for the 2020-2021 Academic Year.** This item will take the bulk of our time as we consider the year ahead. Our committee's mission, primarily, is to support student success generally and to work, in every way possible, to eliminate equity gaps, especially amongst our disproportionately impacted populations. However, for much of last year, the SESC discussed the extent to which many were feeling overwhelmed with the pace of our meetings, the number of topics we were exploring, but at the time, we felt that each of these issues needed attention. And I believe we all understand that we can't

continue that pace this year, that we will burn out if we do. So my hope is that once we all understand the larger equity and success landscape--what programs are in place, the role of the new Equity council, the vision for the new Student Services reorg--we can discuss, as a group, what should our focus be this semester, as a council? How can we make sure we are not inadvertently working at cross purposes, or duplicating work, or ignoring gaps in support? We want to figure out what we can realistically do, as teachers, staff, students, and administrators, to support our students and each other in this unprecedented, overwhelming moment.
