Guest faculty member, Kevin Anderson advised that it has been enhanced so that students who need basic skills would not have to take CIS 001; course will provide basics that local businesses desire such as email, intro to spreadsheet software, etc. There was discussion on whether this course could be used as a GE option D3 or D4 for the AA degree. Kevin advised that it satisfies the requirement for the Gen Ed, but could be altered in the future to a transfer course, but as it stands it is not a transferable. Chairman Brown said he would add a note for option A.

Discussion: Teri advised that the units in all of the courses were too high for a transfer degree; hours were adjusted to reflect a 1-unit class instead of 2-unit courses.

 - i. Action on the course

Discussion: Marianne said the course requires a term paper with APA format, the level of the writing assignment needs a minimum advisory to be in the class; this was raised in the tech review and the teacher stated that she is capable of teaching APA format to her students. Concern was expressed about what happens when the teacher isn't the instructor for the course. Additionally, Jose noted that ENGL 001 teaches how to do research, not necessarily APA format. Erin said if teaching APA format is being taught it should be included in the course objectives. Erin noted that somewhere students need to be taught APA format before being required to use it. Not requiring the APA format as a prerequisite or at least as minimum advisory requirement to be fair to students. Marianne suggested that ENGL 001, LR 010, ENGL 062 and SCC minimum Math be added as an course advisory due to the fact that the course requires a project paper in APA format. Deb noted that the instructor has 3 choices to correct the problem: 1) add the APA to the curriculum 2) add the suggested course advisories 3) remove the APA format requirement.

Vote: Maire motioned to table the course until the instructor can address the APA format issue

Discussion: Marianne inquired if this was a new course; the original subject was women, not gender. Michelle said that this is not a new course; instructor introducing new material. Marianne noted that the course content has been completely changed and needs to go through articulation as it is technically a new course due to extensive course modifications. Needs to be effective for teaching in fall 2016 (with permission to tech new content from VP Minor). Maire advised that it takes a year from approval until the course can be taught. Curtiss advised that original course content must be taught in fall 2016; new content if approved in spring 2017. The committee agreed that the course looks like a new course, and will send back to the originator. It could be taught as an experimental course in the fall, but wouldn't count for GE. The course does say ENGL 001 is a prerequisite so the term paper should not be a problem. Erin said while it is a great course, it needs to be tabled. She complement the author on how she wrote Section G 1, including all the textbooks the library needs to have, encouraged other faculty to follow suit
