20a. High School Articulation Agreement Discussion	VP Williams reminded the committee the importance of faculty to faculty discussions regarding high school articulation. Any articulations will be presented to Curriculum Committee. They also discussed dual enrollment and articulation process.
20b. VP Diamond: Student Centered Funding Formula	VP Diamond discussed, "Student Centered Funding Formula," with the committee members (see attached document). He shared the following information: (a) the number students enrolled in SCC could be dependent on economic status: the higher the job availability, the lower students enrollment, (b) SCC will receive more funds with ADT degree than AA degree, certificates for 16+ units, completion of CTE 19+ units, transfer to four-year-university, completion of transfer level Math or English in first year, attainment of living wage, and extra points for Pell eligible, BOG, & AB 540 students, (c) how Curriculum Committee could assist with SCC student success, (d) utilizing survey to track SCC graduates regarding their major in a 4 year college, and (e) three-year Hold Harmless period.
20c. Stem Cell Program Discussion	Chair DeKloe presented, "hidden pre-requesites," specifically for Stem Cell Program. They discussed its affects to students and the option of waived pre-requisite versus unit requirements with faculty approval.
