1. CALL TO ORDER

Three students stood with Ms. Norman in support of her comments before the Board. President Young thanked Ms. Norman for her comments.

Board President Young called upon Ms. Diane Rieschick, a Benicia resident, who requested to make comments on the current affairs of Solano College. Board President Young thanked Ms. Rieschick for her comments.

Board President Young recognized Trustee Claffey who requested to speak on Items from the Board. Trustee Claffey's comments were deferred to later on the agenda.
