### **SUMMARY:**

Board approval is requested for Resolution No. 11/12-07, establishing the ad valorem tax rates and debt service for the 2011-12 Fiscal Year. Each year, pursuant to Revenue & Taxation Code Section 93, the Board establishes the rates to be levied on the voter-approved bonded indebtedness for Fiscal Year 2011-12. The District is required to furnish the Solano County Auditor-Controller's Office with this information, as well as the 2011-12 debt service requirement. The bonds are general obligations of the District payable solely from the proceeds of ad valorem taxes. The resolution certifies the tax rate and authorizes the County to place an ad valorem tax against the taxable property in the District's service region to pay for the 2005 General Obligation Refunding Bonds and 2006 Series B Bonds.
