Preparation and Requirements for Solano Community College's Registered Nursing Program

Please complete the requirements below to be eligible to apply for the <u>lottery</u> for the Registered Nursing program.

The application period for the RN program lottery is every September.

• Possess a High School Diploma, General Education Development (GED) or California High School Proficiency Exam (CHSPE). Students with a High School Diploma from a school outside the U.S. see the General Information Sheet. An Associate of Arts / Associate of Science degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution exempts students from this requirement.

Complete all of the Nursing Pre-Major required courses with a letter grade of "C" or better

Complete all General Education requirements (Opt. A, IGETC or CSU GE) including a cross-cultural studies course. A
Bachelor Degree or Associate Degree from a regionally accredited institution in U.S. or Canada also fulfills the GE
requirements. Questions about GE requirements can be answered by an SCC Counselor.

- ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) with a score of 62 or higher (within first 2 attempts).
- Composite score of 73 or above. *Grades of "A" or "B" are recommended for English, Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology for the RN program application.* The composite score is determined by a combination of your:
 - o Overall college GPA
 - o ENGL 001 and higher English Course(s) GPA
 - o Core Biology GPA (Anatomy, Physio & Micro, must exceed 3 semester units with lab, no online courses accepted)
 - Core Biology course repetitions (grades of "W", "D", or "F" and number of repeats in Core Biology severely lowers composite score)

Required Prerequisites for Physiology and Microbiology: If you have completed the equivalent to CHEM 010, CHEM 012 or CHEM 001 with a "C" or better at another college, you need to provide a transcript for proof of completion (unofficial is acceptable). We recommend taking one science per semester and sequencing these courses as follows:

Chemistry first, then Anatomy, Physiology, and finally Microbiology and Pharmacology.

Anatomy- BIO 004

(Human Biology-Bio 016 strongly recommended prior to Anatomy)

Intermediate Chemistry-CHEM 010 (4 units)

OR

Chemistry for the Health Sciences-CHEM 012 (5 units)

(Intro. Chemistry- CHEM160 strongly recommended prior to CHEM 010 OR 012 for students who haven't taken Chemistry before)

Physiology-BIO 005

Prerequisite: CHEM 010 or 012 and BIO 004 Highly recommended: Take Anatomy the semester right before Physiology

Prerequisite: CHEM 010 or 012

Microbiology-BIO 014

Pharmacology-NURS 052 Prerequisite: BIO 005
