TEAS EXAMINATION FOR PROSPECTIVE APPLICANTS

In compliance with the Chancellor's Office, all Solano nursing applicants are required to take the "Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)" developed by the Assessment Technologies Institute. For admission to the SCC Registered Nursing Program, a minimum passing composite score of 62% is required within an applicant's *first two* (2) *attempts*. Further information can be found on the http://www.atitesting.com/solutions/pre-program/TEAS-Discover.aspx website regarding TEAS preparation and testing.

The test will be administered in the Assessment Office (Room 442) at Solano Community College during the week of *July 13-16*, 2020, from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm each day. Seats will be available for prospective applicants by appointment only, and at no charge.

Prospective applicants interested in taking the test in July 2020 should:

- 1. Create an account online on the ATI website. Note your ATI username and password.
- 2. Call the Assessment Office at (707) 864-7118 to request an appointment.
- 3. Report to the Assessment Office on the date and time of the exam. Make sure that you have your ATI user name and password when reporting.

Scores from TEAS exams taken at SCC are automatically sent to the Nursing Program and applicants will be able to access their scores online soon after having completed the exam.

Applicants unable to test at SCC in July 2020 may take do so at another location at their own expense. Please request ATI to send scores directly to Solano Community College. *All applicants applying in September 2020 must have their official scores sent to SCC by no later than September 30*, 2020.
