Allison Adcock - Volleyball 2000-02 - Allison was a two year team captain, two-time All-Bay Valley Conference selection and two-time team MVP. She played an additional two years at Lewis and Clark University where she was a two-year Academic All-conference player. Her LCU team won the Frontier conference in 2003 and 2004. She is currently the head VB coach at Vacaville HS.

Kody Keroher - Baseball 2003-05 - Kody was a two year all-conference pitcher and was the recipient of the Tug McGraw Award for two years at Solano. He was drafted by Major League Baseball in 2004, by the Colorado Rockies, but returned to Solano for his sophomore season. He went on to play at the University of Nevada Reno where he was named twice to the Western Athletic Conference All-Academic team. He graduated with a 3.8 gpa with degrees in English and Secondary Education and is currently an assistant baseball coach for the Solano Falcons.

Kim Mitchell Gervasoni - Women's Basketball Coach - 1992-2000-Kim was the women's basketball coach at Solano from 1992 until 2000. She put Solano basketball on the map when she coached the team to the Final Four, national rankings, a #1 State ranking and multiple conference championships. In 2000 she became the lead assistant coach at Arizona State University. Later she became the head coach at the University of Nevada Reno. Currently she lives in Sammamish, WA and is enjoying raising her son Mitchell.

Dave Parsons-Baseball - 1963-65 - Dave was an All-Coast Conference catcher in 1964 and 1965 and was the Coast Conference MVP in 1965 with a .618 batting average on a team that was 12-0 in the conference. His 1964 team was the runner-up in the State and his teams were two-time conference champions. Upon graduating from Solano, Dave got a scholarship to CSU Long Beach. After getting his degree he went on to become a teacher and coach at Vallejo HS for thirty-one years. Dave has won six Vallejo City Golf Championships and in 2006 qualified for the British Senior Open. Dave is now retired and resides with his wife Linda in Benicia.

Gary Passama-Booster – 1995 - current-Gary is currently CEO of NorthBay Healthcare System. He has served in that capacity since its formation in 1987. Gary has been a leader in the Fairfield and Vacaville communities for many years and has been a supporter of Solano Athletics, the Hall of Fame and of Solano College. He serves on the Boards of Directors of the Vacaville Chamber of Commerce, Western Health Advantage Health Plan and the California Healthcare Insurance Company. Gary has a BS in Business Administration and a Masters in Public Health, both from the University of California Berkeley. Also, Gary's niece Rachael was a successful basketball player for Solano College.
