Contractor shall not bill for or be due any portion of this allowance unless the District has identified specific work, Contractor has submitted a price for that work or the District has proposed a price for that work, the District has accepted the cost for that work, and the District has prepared a change order incorporating that work. Contractor hereby authorizes the District to execute a unilateral deductive change order at or near the end of the Project for all or any portion of the allowance not allocated.

- 2. The undersigned has reviewed the Work outlined in the Contract Documents and fully understands the scope of Work required in this Proposal, understands the construction and project management function(s) is described in the Contract Documents, and that each Bidder who is awarded a contract shall be in fact a prime contractor, not a subcontractor, to the District, and agrees that its Proposal, if accepted by the District, will be the basis for the Bidder to enter into a contract with the District in accordance with the intent of the Contract Documents.
- 3. The undersigned has notified the District in writing of any discrepancies or omissions or of any doubt, questions, or ambiguities about the meaning of any of the Contract Documents, and has contacted the Construction Manager before bid date to verify the issuance of any clarifying Addenda.
- 4. The undersigned agrees to commence work under this Contract on the date established in the Contract Documents and to complete all work within the time specified in the Contract Documents.
- 5. The liquidated damages clause of the General Conditions and Agreement is hereby acknowledged.
- 6. It is understood that the District reserves the right to reject this bid and that the bid shall remain open to acceptance and is irrevocable for a period of ninety (90) days.

- 11. Bidder specifically acknowledges and understands that if it is awarded the Contract, that it shall perform the Work of the Project while complying with all requirements of the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR).
- 12. The Bidder represents that it is competent, knowledgeable, and has special skills with respect to the nature, extent, and inherent conditions of the Work to be performed. Bidder further acknowledges that there are certain peculiar and inherent conditions existent in the construction of the Work that may create, during the Work, unusual or peculiar unsafe conditions hazardous to persons and property.
- 13. Bidder expressly acknowledges that it is aware of such peculiar risks and that it has the skill and experience to foresee and to adopt protective measures to adequately and safely perform the Work with respect to such hazards.
- 14. Bidder expressly acknowledges that it is aware that if a false claim is knowingly submitted (as the terms "claim" and "knowingly" are defined in the California False Claims Act, Gov. Code, § 12650 et seq.), the District will be entitled to civil remedies set forth in the California False Claim Act. It may also be considered fraud and the Contractor may be subject to criminal prosecution.

PART 1 GENERAL

1.01 SUMMARY

A. This section includes general information for use of mock-ups. Refer to technical sections for more product-specific mock-up requirements.

1.02 RELATED WORK SPECIFIED ELSEWHERE

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division of Specifications sections apply to this section.

- B. Related sections include, but are not limited to the following:

- C. After award of all subcontracts for separate components and materials of the "exterior wall systems" and on basis of preliminary approval of materials and variations to proposed design, construct full-scale mock-ups for review of each of the following 5 Corbel conditions: Type A1 & A2, Type B1 & B2 and Type C1 as defined in the Project Documents.

1.03 SUBMITTALS

- A. Quality Control Submittals
- 1. Mock-up Plan: Copy of proposed locations for each mock-up, coordinate with the School as to which of the existing corbels shall have a mock-up.
- 2. Locate mock-ups so they do not interfere with the progress of construction.

1.04 DEFINITIONS

A. Mock-ups (General): Full-size physical assemblies that are constructed on the existing building. Mock-ups are constructed to verify selections made under sample submittals; to demonstrate aesthetic effects and qualities of materials and execution; to show interface between dissimilar materials; and to demonstrate compliance with specified details.

- 1. Mock-ups are not Samples.
- 2. Unless otherwise indicated, approved mock-ups establish the standard by which the work will be judged.

1.05 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Mock-up Plan: Detailed, dimensioned plans and elevations showing mock-up size, and items and materials that will be included in proposed mock-up.

B. Pre-Construction Approval: Prior to the construction of the mock-up, a conference will be called by the Construction Manager at the Site for the purpose of reviewing the requirements, and intent of mock-up. The conference shall be attended by the Construction

Manager, Owner, Contractor, and person supervising this phase of the Work.

D. Mock-ups, if accepted and fully functional, shall remain in place and form part of the final work.

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.01 INSTALLATION

- A. Once plan is approved by Construction Manager, build mock-ups for each form of construction and finish as directed.
- 1. Build mock-ups in approved location and of size and profile indicated or, or as directed by the Architect.
- 2. Notify the Architect and Construction Manager of 7 days in advance of dates and times when mock-ups will be constructed and able to be inspected.
- 3. Employ supervisory personnel to oversee mock-up construction. Employ same workers that will be employed during the construction of Project.
- 4. Demonstrate the proposed range of aesthetic effects and workmanship.
- 5. Commence the Work after mock-up has been inspected and approved in writing by the Owner.
- 6. The mock-up will establish the standard of quality of workmanship by which the Work will be judged.
- 7. If approved by the Owner, maintain mock-ups in an undisturbed condition as a standard for judging the completed Work. Failure to maintain the mock-up, until directed, will be cause for rejection of the Work.
- B. Mock-up Types: Construct mock-up in accordance with approved shop drawings, project manual, and Contract Drawings, using exact materials and methods approved for the Project, including required accessories.
- 1. Integrated Exterior Mock-ups: Coordinate installation of exterior envelope materials and products for which mock-ups are required in individual Specification Sections and supporting materials.
- a. Mock-up shall include all elements of the exterior wall, demonstrating surface and material changes from the ground to the roof cornice/coping trim.
- b. Mock-ups shall be complete in all respects and shall represent the final complete exterior "wall assembly" including precast concrete elements, glazing, stone panels, exterior insulated masonry finish system, sealants and metal finishes.
