Solano Community College and Vallejo Center Dean Shirley Lewis, were recently recognized for support of employees who serve in the Guard and Reserve of the U.S. military.

Dr. Lewis is the recipient of the "Patriot Award" from the Office of the Secretary of Defense for "Contributing to National Security and Protecting Liberty and Freedom by Supporting Employee Participation in America's National Guard and Reserve Force.
