

After clubbing his first home run of the season on Monday, Diaz homered in back-to-back at-bats Thursday in a 6-5 Solano win.

The athletic middle infielder from Vallejo also played spotless defense recording 12 putouts & 10 assists without an error.

Solano has now won 5 in a row and 7 of their last 8.
