



"The Chronicle of Higher Education" (8/23/19) ranked SCC #10 in the nation in the category, "Colleges With the Greatest Racial and Ethnic Diversity Among Students, Fall 2017" and gave the college a 78.3 in the Diversity Index. "The Diversity Index indicates on a scale of 1 to 100 the probability that any two students at the institution are from different racial or ethnic groups." SCC was listed in the top 10 of 4-year public institutions because we offer a BS degree. CSU East Bay ranked #9 on the list.

Science & Veterans Building Dedicated



The Science Building and Veterans Resource Center was dedicated last week. The 44,000 square foot, state of the art facility will allow the college to increase offerings in the sciences and increase support services for veterans, active military, and their families.

The facility boasts a state of the art anatomy cadaver dissection area, labs for Chemistry
