Volleyball: The Solano women's volleyball team cruised to wins over Gavilan, 3-1, and Siskyous, 3-0, on Friday afternoon to open the Solano Classic #1.

Against Gavilan, scores were 25-23, 22-25, 26-24, 27-25. And set scores were 25-11, 25-16, 25-18 against Siskyous.

Sophomore <u>Haley del Rio</u> and freshman <u>Lindsey</u>

<u>McLaughlin</u> combined for 36 of the team's total 51 kills against Gavilan. McLaughln was errorless hitting out of the middle with 14 kills on 19 attempts (.737), adding five total blocks, four solo, and three service aces. del Rio

added her second double-double of the season with a team-high 17 digs.

Despite another double-double performance by sophomore <u>Haley del Rio</u>, the Falcons fell in the Solano Classic #1 finale to Feather River in four on Saturday afternoon. Set scores were 25-18, 25-21, 20-25, 25-17.

Women's Soccer: Freshman <u>Keana Flynn</u> netted a pair of goals in the Solano women's soccer team's 2-2 push with Cosumnes River on Friday afternoon in the Falcons' home opener.

Flynn gave the Falcons the early lead off an assist from sophomore <u>Melinda</u> <u>Rashidian</u> before Cosumnes River tied the match heading into halftime. Solano broke the stalemate in the 59th minute on Flynn's second goal, assisted by sophomore <u>Karla</u> <u>Cardinal</u>. But the Hawks equalized the match with about 15 minutes remaining. Sophomore keeper <u>Kirstyn Gotschall</u> counted four saves.

The Falcons (0-0-2) resume action on Tuesday, Sept. 3 at Ohlone. Match time is set for 4 p.m.
