Volleyball: The Solano women's volleyball team



lost a pair of matches to Cabrillo, 3-0, and Foothill, 3-1, on Friday to open the Delta Classic, hosted by San Joaquin Delta College. Set scores against Cabrillo were 25-23, 25-21, 25-23, and 20-25, 25-19, 25-22, 25-19 against Foothill.

The team rebounded with a pair of wins over San Francisco, 3-1, and Shasta, 3-0, on Saturday in the final day of the Delta Classic, hosted by San

Joaquin Delta.

Sophomore Haley del Rio and freshman **Lindsey McLaughlin** led the Falcon offense against San Francisco with 16 kills each. del Rio added 12 more against Shasta. McLaughlin added a pair of aces against San Francisco and four blocks against Shasta. Freshman middle blocker **Mylei Moli** added four blocks against Shasta as well. Freshman **Kayla Somontan** directed the offense with 68 assists on the day with 41 against San Francisco.

Solano (6-5) returns home to host the Solano Classic #2. The Falcons will face Sacramento City at 3:30 p.m. before taking on Reedley at 5:30 p.m.



Women's Soccer: Freshman Keana Flynn scored in the 17th minute to give the Falcons an early advantage, but the Solano women's soccer team fell 3-2 at Modesto on Friday afternoon.

Solano dominated possession in the first half and Flynn scored her third goal of the season off of a sophomore **Brooke Molina** assist. But Modesto scored back-to-back goals to take a 2-1 edge into the break.

Modesto capitalized on a free kick in the 55th minute to lead 3-1 before sophomore **Isabel**

Olmedo earned her first score of the season off a feed from freshman Borges in the 73rd minute. The Falcons had a penalty kick attempt late in the match, but was unable to convert.

Sophomore **Kirstyn Gotschall** counted 11 saves on the day in the goal. Solano (1-1-2) returns home to host San Francisco on Tuesday, Sept. 10 at 4 p.m.
