Rodriguez threw 2.1 on the bump, allowing only one hit, after sophomore **Edgar Aqui-Cruz** (1-0) started the game, throwing five complete and scattering four hits.

Offensively, four Falcons earned a double in the game of the team's six total hits, led by freshman **Herbie Lane**'s RBI-double down the left field line in the sixth.
