

How to use the CCCC Management Information Systems Data Mart

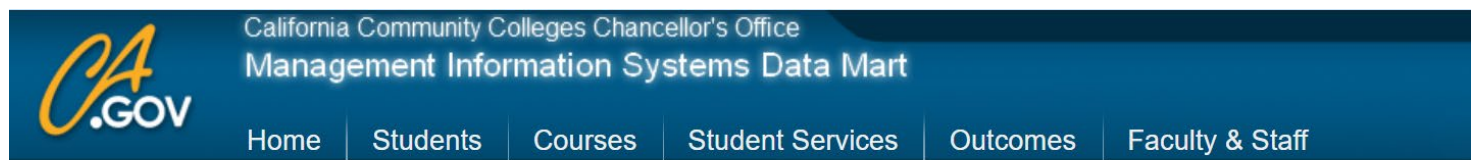
Navigating CCCC Management Information Systems Data Mart

The Chancellor's Office of the California Community College System collects enrollment, demographic, and other student data from all its constituent institutions within 30 days after the end of each term. These data may be accessed via the Management Information System (MIS) Data Mart at the college, district, and statewide levels by term and academic year.

The Data Mart contains several pre-defined reports that are available to the public. It allows for the easy development of these reports, and the download of aggregate data in comma-delimited files for analysis and longitudinal tracking. Usually one or more criteria (for example: student age category, gender, enrollment status, ethnicity, or instructional discipline) can be used to group the output data on the reports.

Students/Headcounts

Reports showing student counts, with demographic breakouts if desired, by:

- o Annual/Term Student Count
- o Enrollment Status
- o Day/Evening Status

- o Full-time Equivalent Student (FTES) Counts

Courses/Calendar

Various reports showing course characteristics such as TOP code, credit status, SAM code, etc. as well as how the course was offered such as day / evening status and accounting method. The reports include:

- o Counts of sections offered, students enrolled, and FTES by credit course characteristics
- o Counts of sections offered, students enrolled, and FTES by noncredit course characteristics
- o Counts of sections offered, students enrolled, and FTES by basic skills course characteristics
- o List of courses offered during a term with section counts and characteristics
- o Academic Calendar Summary for all colleges for a fiscal year
- o Academic Calendar for a district for a fiscal year
- o College Master Course/Program File
