

Minimum Eligibility for Junior Transfer Admission to California Public Colleges

CSU - California State University

60 CSU transferable units
(SCC course # 001-099)

30 units of CSU GE with a 'C' or better
(39 GE units are required for some CSU campuses)

GE areas A-1, A-2, A-3, and B-4
must be completed with a 'C' or better

Minimum GPA of 2.0

UC - University of California

60 UC transferable units
(SCC course # 001-049)

*Two transferable English composition courses
(Completed with a 'C' or better)

*One transferable mathematical concepts and
quantitative reasoning course (Completed with a 'C' or
better)

*4 transferable courses from at least two different
subject areas (arts and humanities, social and
behavioral sciences, and physical and biological
sciences.)(Completed with a 'C' or better)

Minimum GPA of 2.4

**courses must be 3 semester or 4-5 quarter units each*

Selection Criteria:

Some schools have more applicants than space available and so they impose additional selection criteria.
