

LGBTQ students enrolled or intending to enroll at an accredited community college based in the United States, including Hawaii and Alaska, in the Fall of 2020 can apply. Students must have 1-2 years of community college left AND

(1) intending to transfer to a bachelor's degree program at a four-year college or university for Fall 2021 or Fall 2022 OR

(2) graduate with an associates degree.

The Point Foundation Community College Program inspires LGBTQ community college students to fulfill their ambitions of graduating with an associate's degree and/or transferring to a four-year college or university. Students accepted into the program will receive a financial award between

\$2,000 - \$4,800

as well as professional transfer coaching at a multi-day symposium in Los Angeles and opportunities to network with Point Scholars and Alumni.

Applicants will be evaluated on academic performance and potential, financial need, their involvement in school and community, and goals for the future. Recipients of the one-year Point Community College Scholarship agree to participate in Point programs and events related to their scholarship.
