Students will be required to attend a Mandatory Orientation in January. Location TBD. Please check the online schedule for up to date information. Students must have a valid BLS for Healthcare Providers to be considered eligible for entry. The Mandatory Prerequisites: Fire 128 or EMT 128, First Responder. Students successfully completing the course are eligible to take the National Registry Emergency Medical Technician (Basic) Exam as required by the state of California for certification. Certification enables students to qualify for employment with ambulance services, fire, or rescue services, search & rescue crews, ski patrol or related pre-hospital emergency care positions. NOTE: By law, applicants for certification must be at least 18 years of age. Students must present current Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers course completion card at the orientation meeting in order to enroll in the course. Students will be responsible for Certified Background Checks and drug screens, purchasing EMT Uniforms, and EMT Skills Kits. Dean Authorization is required for registration once Lottery has been completed.
