A. SparkPoint Solano.

i. Harley is a certified credit counselor and financial coach for Sparkpoint in Solano County for eleven years. The program provides financial and credit coaching, counseling, career, and employment services.

ii. The program does research in case students need rental assistance and the program has twenty five centers through the San Francisco Bay Area and most of the centers are located in community colleges, elementary schools, and SparkPoint just opened a center at University of San Francisco. Furthermore, there is a new center at the community college in San Francisco.

iii. Most of the clients ask for financial assistance and the program helps them to find available resources. Moreover, the program can help the students with budgeting and financial management and the meetings are confidential.

iv. SparkPoint has a bilingual certified credit counselor and the program also helps the students to understand and manage their credit score. In addition, students learned more about their rights and responsibilities as consumers.

v. Johnny Seymore works for SparkPoint and he can help students to build a resume

and write a cover letter. In addition, he does mock interviews and has access to job search. He can teach you how to stay motivated when looking for a job. Lately, The program is located in building 400 and students can have virtual appointments..
