Positive Attendance Hours

Per CCCCO guidance, *submit your best estimate* of the number of hours students *would have completed* had the semester concluded normally.

(**Remember**: We are paid by student hours completed, so under-estimates directly reduce district apportionment.)

Earlier Withdrawals

The COVID-19 crisis resulted in the first cancellations of college activities in California beginning in the second week of March. However, Chancellor Oakley's Executive Order permits colleges to grant the EW grade as early as March 4, 2020. *Consequently...*

If a "W" is recorded on a student's transcript for withdrawal from a course between March 4, 2020 and the end of Spring 2020, Admissions and Records staff will convert this transcript notation to an "EW".

Petition Forms

To expedite converting student grades, students may submit the new "Easy Spring 2020 Grade Change Petition" through May 14, 2020.

After May 14, students may submit a "regular" Grade Change Petition, citing the COVID-19 crisis as the justification for the grade change.

Either of these petitions will be *automatically approved*, meaning that the grade change request will be granted without need for additional intervention by the professor or administration. Admissions and Records staff will adjust course grades manually and individually based on petitions.



Easy Spring 2020 Grade Change Petition Deadline


Spring 2020 Student Grade Option Flowchart

May 14, 2020 – (Thursday two weeks after last final) – Submit "Easy Spring 2020 Grade Change Petition" to automatically convert grades as shown below.

After May 14, 2020 – Students may submit a "regular" grade change petition

Course repetition rules have been waived by the State Chancellor's Executive Order – students may petition to repeat any Spring 2020 course for grade improvement at any time in future.
