Re: Guided Pathways Update

Date: 5 October 2020

To remind senators, Guided Pathways was unilaterally moved from Academic Affairs to Student Services, and is now under the direction of VP Cooper. This shift was made in late June/early July. The Guided Pathways Coordinator learned of the change on August 14, the Friday prior to Fall 2020 term.

Since that time, the GP Coordinator has met twice with VP Cooper in effort to align past work with current efforts. We continue to meet twice per month. Current emphasis is on student on-boarding and intrusive counseling, to include the use of predictive data. This later effort is a continuation of last year's discussion re: completion success teams.

It is my current understanding that the intent is to develop intrusive counseling strategies into existing support resources, notably TAP and student ambassadors. To my knowledge, these efforts are still nascent and are to be tied to the work of the student services task force to be assembled by VP Cooper. See Project #4 below for more here.

For the Fall 2020 term, VP Cooper and I have agreed to the following projects and approximate timeline(s), one commensurate with the recent reduction in release for the position, 100% to 40%. Please also see the attached document for copy of the newly revised course sequence template.

Project #1

Finalize development of new ADTs. Completion goal: late September/early October 2020. Includes:

- Review of revised content, including counseling and/or faculty review where appropriate, for version 2.0 of the ADT recommended course sequences. Revised materials forwarded James Thomas media in August 2020, with additional minor revisions from Counseling. (Completed, August 2020).
- Review and approval of revised template. See attached for example. (Completed September 2020, final version pending administrative approval.)
- Identification of on-going point person charged with periodic updates. Suggest Lisa Abbot/Curriculum Specialist in cooperation with Curriculum and Academic Affairs.

Project #2

Development of GE Template. Completion goal: October 2020. Includes:

- Development of possible GE templates based on new ADT course sequences to inform future planning, including subsequent course sequences and scheduling. (mid-October 2020)
- VP Cooper to present to Academic Affairs and/or scheduling deans for input. (October 2020)
- Finalize development in cooperation with Student Services and Academic Affairs (~October 2020).

Project #3

Curriculum and Program Review Processes. October-November 2020. Includes:

- Propose additions/changes to the Curriculum and Program Review Handbooks to capture current process for development of recommended course sequences and meta-major placement where relevant. (October 2020)
- Process for review of existing programs and development of new programs to include review of recommended course sequence for all programs in a six-year cycle. (~October 2020)
- Process for placement of programs in metamajors. Explore the need for a periodic review by the CC. (October 2020)
- Senate approval in consultation with senate subcommittees. (~November 2020)
- On-going questions: how would this look in eLumen? Who figures this out? Approves changes?

Project #4

Participation in Student Services Reorganization Committee, to replace the Guided Pathways Steering Committee for Fall 2020. Timeline TBD

Currently awaiting formation of the advisory committee. Focus in GP would be wayfinding, student-onboarding--including career-informed pathways selection--Math and English self-placement, planning for pathways development, and intrusive student outreach to include the use of predictive data.
