Data Collection

All data featured was obtained from Solano Community Colleges' student information system, Banner. Student general and student course data, where available, are included for fall 2019, fall 2020, and fall 2021. Students' course registration statuses that did not count towards registration were excluded. Included are course registrations RA, RE, RW, DI, WL, WN. Tutr 500 and Math 505 were excluded from the data.

For the success calculation, a student's course grade is counted positively towards the success calculation when the student has earned an A, B, C, or P as a final grade. Average success rates can be interpreted as the percent of passed enrollments that were graded (the sum of graded enrollments with grades A, B, C, or P divided by the sum of all graded enrollments).

For the end-of-term (EOT) retention calculation, a student's course enrollment is counted positively towards the end-of-term calculation when a student has earned any grade other than a W. Average course end-of-term retention rates reflect the average number of enrollments retained after the census date with a grade that is not a W.

The Percentage Point Gap Minus One (PPG-1) Method is used in this report to examine equity. The PPG-1 Method is the recommended method by the Chancellor's Office to look for disproportionately impacted groups in the attainment of measurable outcomes. The percentage point gap is calculated based on the outcome rate of the subgroup under comparison subtracted from the outcome rate of all subgroups. The percentage point gap value is evaluated to a computed margin of error to see if the value represents an instance of disproportionate impact. Throughout the report, average course success and end-of-term retentions rates of subgroups within the different analysis groups are compared using the PPG-1 method to evaluate gaps and identify groups that are disproportionately impacted (DI).


Institutional Rates

Below are Solano College's total headcount, enrollments, average success, and average end-of-term (EOT) retention rates for the terms in this report. Fall 2020 and Fall 2021 were terms impacted by the Covid-19 Pandemic.

Observations:

- Fall 2021 enrollment, headcount, average course success rate, and end-of-term retention rate are lower than the counts and rates from fall 2020.

Headcount, Enrollment, Course Success and End-of-Term Retention (Term)





Demographics

Headcount by Ethnicity Category

The students' self-reported ethnicity selection is placed into an ethnicity category that was collected. Observations:

- The percentage of students that identify as Hispanic showed growth in Fall 2021 over the percentage in Fall 2019 and Fall 2020. Students that identify as Hispanic students make up 33.59% of registered students.






Headcount Diffences From Previous Fall Term, Ethnicity Category


Headcount by Gender

Gender information was gathered from self-reported information found in Banner. Observations:

- In Fall 2021, females continue to make up more than half of the registered student population, however, the percentage decreased from 59.32% in Fall 2020 to 56.66% in Fall 2021.
- The percentage of males increased from 38.47% in Fall 2020 to 41.00% in Fall 2021.




Headcount Diffences From Previous Fall Term, Gender Groups



Headcount by Age Group

Students' ages at the beginning of the semester were grouped into three (3) categories: 18 or under, between 18 and 25, and 25 or over. The null category was for records where a date of birth was not recorded. Observations:

- In Fall 2021, the headcount for students between 18 and 25 was lower than in Fall 2020, but the group continued to make up the largest part of the registered population at 38.75%.




Headcount by Informed/Declared Goal

Education goals were taken from the informed/declared education goal fields in Banner and grouped by journey type. An Informed goal is entered in a student's record after having received a student service such as assessment, orientation, counseling, or other student services which expands a student's understanding of the requirements necessary to achieve the goal.

Observations:

- Of the students with an informed/declared education goal, students whose goal is to obtain a degree and/or transfer continue to make up more than half of the registered student population.




Headcount by Unit Load

Students' total units or unit load were grouped into five (5) categories: zero (0) units, less than 6 units, 6 to 9 units, between 9 to 12 units, and 12 or more units.

Observations:

- In Fall 2021, students with less than 6 units made up 33.05% of the registered population; they continue to make up the majority of the student population.
- 23.41% of registered students took 12 or more units in Fall 2021 compared to 22.03% in the previous fall term.



Headcount by Student Population

Students' student type was collected from Banner to show the population the student belonged to. Observations:

- Fall 2021, saw an increase in the percentage of continuing students and first-time students and a decrease in the percentage of returning students within the registered students, compared to Fall 2020.




Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention

Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Day vs. Evening Courses

Courses' begin times were grouped into categories according to the definition of day and evening courses used in the Student Attendance Accounting Manual in line with Title V. The null category is for courses where the course begin time is not recorded, such as for online courses. Due to scheduling allowances and schedule changes because of the pandemic, the category for Null grew significantly in Fall 2020 and Fall 2021. Observations:

- The enrollment volume of the null category has increased due to most classes being scheduled online in Fall 2020 and Fall 2021.
- In Fall 2021, enrollments in evening scheduled courses had a higher average course success rate (73.5%) than online or daytime scheduled courses.
- In Fall 2021, enrollments in evening scheduled courses had slightly higher end-of-term retention (87.6%) than online courses.
- Collectively, the day courses had the lowest course success rate.

Further analysis of course schedule type by ethnicity categories shows that in Fall 2021: 02/07/22

- The average success rates of Black Non-Hispanic registered in the daytime, evening, and online courses are lower than the other groups. The gap highlights Black Non-Hispanic students as a disproportionately impacted group in these course categories.

Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Schedule Type

Courses' schedule types were grouped into two (2) categories: online or face-to-face to show enrollments, course success, and end-of-term retention in the chart below. Observations:

- The volume of courses recorded as online increased due to most classes being scheduled online in Fall 2021, hence the larger volume of online enrollments.
- In Fall 2021, enrollments in face-to-face courses continue to have higher course success and end-of-term retention rates than online courses.



Enrollment, Course Success and End-of-Term Retention (Schedule Type)

Further analysis of course schedule type by ethnicity categories shows that in Fall 2021:

 Students in online courses that identify as Black Non-Hispanic and those that identify as Hispanic, had low success rates and were disproportionately impacted in online courses when comparing success rates using the PPG-1 method.

- Black Non-Hispanic and Hispanic in online classes had below-average end-of-term retention rates. Black Non-Hispanic and Hispanic students in online courses were disproportionately impacted when comparing end-of-term retention rates using the PPG-1 method.
- Students in Face-to-Face courses that identify as Black Non-Hispanic and Hispanic students continue to have the lowest success rates. Black Non-Hispanic students in face-to-face courses were disproportionately impacted when comparing their success rate to that of the other groups, using the PPG-1 method.



Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Ethnicity Category

When grouping students only by the ethnicity category selected and not factoring in the number of races selected:

- Hispanic students generate the largest number of enrollments in Fall 2021.
- In Fall 2021, students that identify as American Indian or Alaskan Native (83.5%) and Black Non-Hispanic (81.9%) had the lowest end-of-term retention rates. Hispanic and Black Non-Hispanic students continued to be disproportionately impacted groups when comparing their end-of-term retention to other groups.
- In Fall 2021, students that identify as Hispanic (67.3%) and Black Non-Hispanic (58.4%) had the lowest success rates and were disproportionately impacted when comparing success rates under the PPG-1 method.

Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Gender

Gender information was gathered from self-reported information found in Banner.

Observations:

- In Fall 2021, students that identify as female generated the most enrollments.
- The average course success for all groups has decreased in Fall 2021, to a lower rate than in Fall 2019 or Fall 2020.
- Further evaluation using the PPG-1 Method established males as a disproportionately disadvantaged group when comparing average success rates by gender for the past two fall terms, however, that was not the case in Fall 2021, when the difference in success rates was lower.

- Female students that identified as Black Non-Hispanic were disproportionately impacted when comparing course success rates and end-of-term retention rates by gender and ethnicity.

- Male students that identified as Black Non-Hispanic and those that identify as Hispanic were disproportionately impacted when comparing course success rates by gender and ethnicity.
- Male students that identified Black Non-Hispanic were disproportionately impacted when comparing end-of-term retention rates by gender and ethnicity.

Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Age Group

Students' ages at the beginning of the semester were grouped into three (3) categories: 18 or under, between 18 and 25, and 25 or over. The null category was for records where a date of birth was uncollected. Observations:

- In Fall 2021, students 25 or over had the highest average course success rate and average end-of-term retention rate.
- In Fall 2021, students between 18 and 25 were identified as a disproportionately impacted group for average course success. They generated 42% of enrollments; the success rate for those enrollments is 69.9%. Students 18 or younger were also identified as disproportionately impacted when comparing their average course success rate to that of the other two groups.


Enrollments, Course Success, and End-of-Term Retention by Declared Education Goal

Education Goals were taken from students informed/declared education goal field in Banner and grouped by journey type.

Observations:

 In Fall 2021, students with the informed goal for degree and transfer generated 71.25% of enrollments, their course success rate was 69.3% and their end-of-term retention rate was 86.3%. The degree/transfer group was identified as disproportionately impacted when comparing their average course success and end-of-term retention rates to the rates of the other groups.



Students' total units (or unit load) were grouped into five (5) categories: zero (0) units, less than 6 units, 6 to 9 units, between 9 to 12 units, and 12 or more units.

Observations:

- In Fall 2021, students with 12 or more units had the highest average success (84.3%) and the highest _ end-of-term retention rate (98.6%).
- In Fall 2021, students with less than 6 units had the lowest average success rate (61.4%) and the lowest end-of-term retention rate (80.7%).
- Students with unit loads of less than 6 units and those with 6 to 9 units were disproportionately impacted when comparing average success rates by unit load under the PPG-1 method. These same groups were disproportionately impacted when comparing their end-of-term retention rates to those of the other groups.



- In Fall 2021, first-time and returning students were disproportionately impacted groups when comparing the course success and end-of-term retention rates by student population under the PPG-1 method.

Headcount, Enrollment, Course Success and End-of-Term Retention (CalWorks)




