SEA FUNDING - EXAMPLES

- ► Contract Services
 - PSA's, contracts, travel/mileage, professional development, dues/membership, events, software, etc.
- **▶** Equipment
- Direct Student Aid
 - Emergency grants, emergency housing, etc. (now moved to dedicated funding allocation)

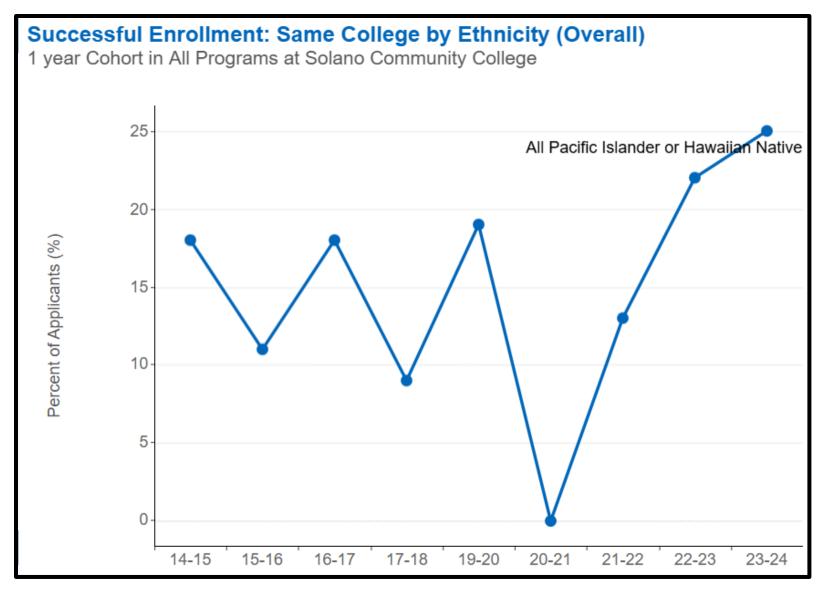
2022-2025 SEA Plan 2.0 Outcomes

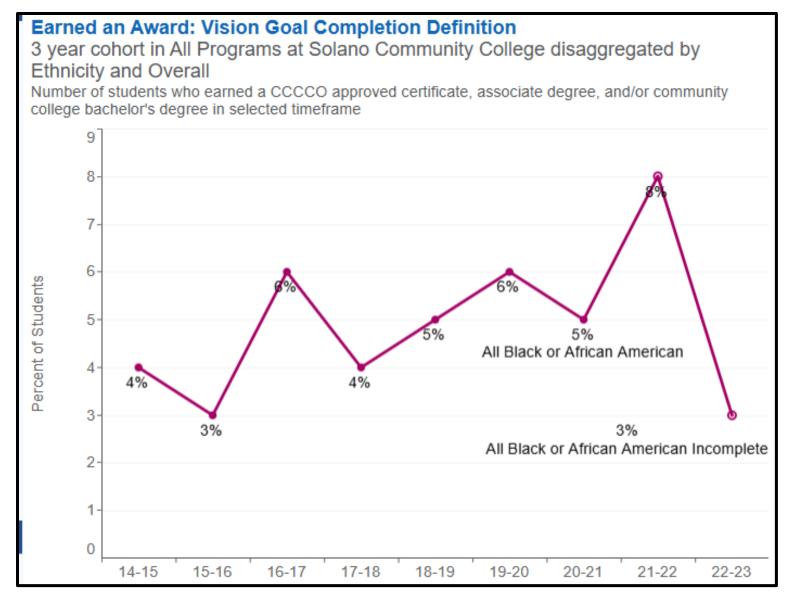

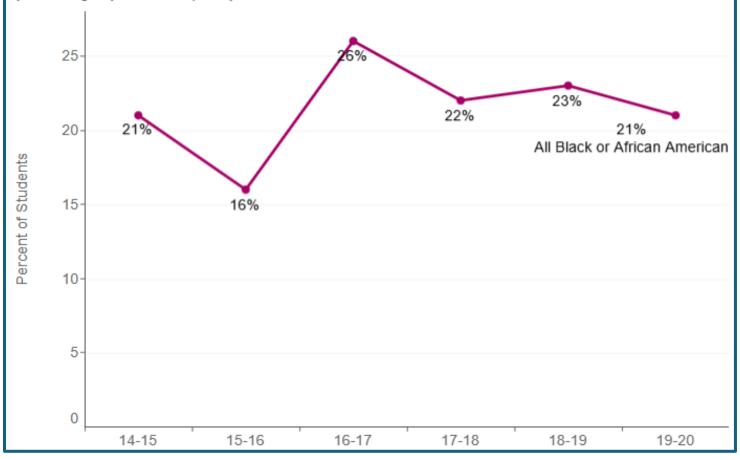
