Upon completion of this program, the student will earn a Certificate of Achievement for the Solano Community College Fire Academy, a SFM FF1 Certificate, and an EMT Certificate. Upon successfully achieving the SCC FF1 Academy Certificate, the student would be eligible to apply to fire service agencies nation-wide.

#### **Program Outcomes**

Students who complete the Firefighter 1 Academy Certificate of Achievement will be able to:

- 1. Perform manipulate skills and pass written tests that meet the National Fire Protection Association Standard 1001 and the California State Fire Marshal standard for Firefighter 1 & 2
