In order to have access to the application you must first create an account.

For FAFSA student and parents will create an FSA ID.

For CA Dream Act student and parent will create an Dream Act Account.

To create this account you will need your name, date of birth, social security number, current phone number, current mailing address.

What documents Do I need to Fill out the FAFSA or Ca Dream Act application:

For Identification:

- -Social Security number
- -Driver's license number
- -Parent's Social Security numbers (For dependent students under the age of 24)
 -Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. Citizen
 -ITIN number for students and parents

For Taxes:

(2022 taxes for 2024-2025 aid year) (2023 taxes for 2025-26 aid year)

- -Self-tax information (1040 IRS forms and W2's) for students who are single or married.
- -Parent tax information (1040 IRS forms and W2's) if they are single or married. (Only requested for dependent students under the age of 24)
 - -Authorization to Retrieve Federal Tax Information
- -Records of untaxed incomes, such as child support received, interest income, and veteran's non-education benefits, for you or you and your parents.
 - -Tax documents can include: IRS 1040, Foreign tax return, IRS 1040NR, or IRS 1040nr-ez.
 - -Tax returns for Puerto Rico, Guam, America Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, or Pal Au.

Bank Information:

- -Current Bank Statements if needed (checking and savings account balances)
- Monetary Information such as cash on hand, investments including stocks and bonds, real estate(s) (but not including the home in which you live), and business and farm assets for you or you and your parents.
