Superintendent-President, Dr. Esposito-Noy gave the following comments regarding the retirement of Charles Eason:

Chuck Eason serves as the Statewide Director for Business and Entrepreneurship Sector for the California Community Colleges Economic and Workforce Development Program and coordinates the small business programs at the 116 community colleges across the state. He has also held previous statewide leadership positions as the Associate Director of the California Community Colleges Statewide Economic Development Network and former chair of the Small Business Programs committee. In his prior positions as the Napa Valley College and Solano College Small Business Development Center (SBDC) Director and the Inland Empire Business Incubator Manager, Chuck provided training and counseling to thousands of entrepreneurs over the past twenty-five years. He is also a Small Business Innovation and Research (SBIR) Specialist with the Norcal SBDC Tech Futures Group. Chuck started his career working in the defense industry as a systems engineer for TRW's Ballistic Missile Program.

Over the years, Chuck worked closely with numerous faculty on a number of projects including the NASDAQ internship and various small business development opportunities. Most recently, Chuck has worked with the Governor's Office on the DoD CASCADE II grant which placed community college students in cybersecurity internships and DoD (Dept of Defense) companies across the state. Currently, he is finalizing a grant for the National Science Foundation Innovation Engines Project MICRO, a grant for up to \$160 million over ten years. Included in this grant will be internships for SCC faculty and students.

Chuck has served the California community college system for 25 years. We were fortunate to have him on our campus creating innovative opportunities for our students. Chuck and his family have been part of the SCC community. His wife Angela continues to work with our Science programs and their daughter Grace graduated from ECHS and transferred to Cal Poly San Luis Obispo as a Math major.
