### OPEN MEETING

- Melissa has not yet spoken with David about previous catalog information in the MAPS
- Selecting a date for the Spring Open House -
  - If we want to invite HS's the sooner we need a date or ballpark of the date so we can run the date by VP Williams and VP Neely etc
    - First step - Spring Breaks of local districts as well as priority registration
      - ✓ April 21st; April 28th or May 5th
        - Ideal date may be Friday, April 28th
        - Should we connect with Outreach also so that we should make sure we don't duplicate what they are already planning to do
      - ❖ Melissa will check Vallejo and Benicia Spring Break for the GPS Spring Event
      - ❖ Invite Alisa and Jesus to one of the next meetings; they may have more ideas about what they would like to do or they may have events already planned we can build on rather than compete

### Continuing to plan for November activity – “GPS Program Showcase”

- Melissa was able to announce the event at the Senate Meeting and the Management Meeting. But hasn't done any contacting of specific departments that we had identified
- Placeholder on the 10/11 flex calendar for a GPS session - no session description
  - Could it be a planning session for departments that will be participating in the November event?
  - This is often appreciated for faculty that they can get it on the calendar and get flex credit for it and not have to add planning of their own time.
  - Melissa will draft an email to the departments & get it out to the departments today or tomorrow.

      - Will organize the Departments by who their GPS Coordinator is for more information and help with planning.
      - “GPS Program Showcase”
  - ❖ Need to get a Guided Pathways Program Showcase flyer during the Find the Falcon in October to get it on people's radar - as it gets closer to event
  - ❖ Find the Falcon on October 13th in the NEST - large student lounge room in Building 400 focus on Timely Care and Student Health and Wellness
    - Melissa reach out to the ASTC about setting a table up a week before the “Program Showcase” event to promote the even & Guided Pathways
    - GPS Program Showcase in November is for current students

    - Ideal to try to get all the coordinators there and identified as dept leads to confirm the information
  - Carlos also had ideas for sharing during class time and consider the pathways and where they are for the various majors - show them how to access it
    - IF you get a few - that would be nice
    - If the department leads know this and are showing students about MAPS it's helpful
    - Response is difficult – but BIOTECH is already on board and ready to do this
      - Carlos forward email to Melissa on what he sent to his contacts
      - FYI - Math and Science will be doing program review on October Flex date
