FIBER RING REPAIR PROJECT**

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**SUMMARY:**

The damaged fiber ring was “patch” repaired to restore operation of the data network on campus temporarily. The I.T. Department has evaluated the patch and determined that the District’s Data network is at risk of failure until the optical fiber ring is fully restored and tested. A proposal was requested from Integrity Data & Fiber Inc., (IDF), who designed and installed the current fiber ring. IDF is a contractor on the District’s Pre-Approved Contractor list for the District’s Board Approved CUPCAA (California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act) program. The proposal was reviewed, and the proposed pricing was determined to be fair and appropriate to the scope of work requested.

The Board is asked to approve a contract to Integrity Data & Fiber in the amount of \$37,000.
