HYDRONIC LOOP – B300 & 1200 VAULT REPAIR PROJECT (FORMAL BID - PROJECT #25-023)

- Q. Where can I find information about the Hydronic Loop B300 & 1200 Vault Repair Project No. 25-023?

Q. What is the scope for this project?

- A. Excavation, Demolition, and Installation of Heating Hot Water Pipe in two Vault Locations on the Fairfield Campus. Cleaning and Inspection of Chilled Water Pipe at same locations. Full scope of work shown in Contract Documents.
- Q. What is the anticipated start and duration for this project?
- A. The anticipated construction duration is May 5th, 2025 August 6th, 2025.
- Q. What is the Construction Estimate for this project?
- A. The estimate for this project is \$600,000.
- Q. Will there be a MANDATORY WALK for this project?
- A. There will be a MANDATORY Virtual Pre-Bid Conference (web-based meeting via Microsoft Teams) Thursday, March 6th, 2025 at 11:00 AM. All interested parties must register through the following link (<u>REGISTER HERE</u>).
