WHAT: Attempted Strong Arm

Robbery

WHERE: Near Building 100

WHEN: February 27, 2019, 10:50 AM

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

A student reported she was walking near building 100 when an unknown male suspect approached her from her right side and attempted to grab her purse, umbrella and her rolling backpack, from her person. She held on to her items and ran towards building 100 where she got a staff member to contact the Campus Sheriff's Office to report the incident. Deputies arrived within minutes but the suspect had fled the area in an unknown direction. No one was hurt and no weapons were scene on the suspect.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION:

Hispanic male adult, 5'5", heavy build, in his 20s, small mustache, with short hair and had a tan/khaki backpack.

SAFETY TIPS:

- STAY ALERT TO YOUR SURROUNDINGS AND KEEP HIGH VALUE ITEMS OUT OF SIGHT.
- WHEN POSSIBLE, TRAVEL WITH ANOTHER PERSON. THERE IS SAFETY INNUMBERS.
- IF YOU MUST TRAVEL AT NIGHT, WALK AND PARK IN WELL-LIT AREAS.
- KNOW WHERE YOU ARE GOING. WALK QUICKLY AND CONFIDENTLY TO YOUR DESTINATION.
- AVOID CARRYING UNECESSARY ITEMS.
- HOLD PURSES, BRIEFCASES AND PACKAGES TIGHTLY AND CLOSE TO YOUR BODY.
- HAVE YOUR KEYS OUT AND READY BEFORE APPROACHING YOUR CAR.
- CHECK BOTH THE FRONT AND REAR SEATS OF YOUR VEHICLE BEFORE ENTERING. LOCK THE DOOR IMMEDIATELY UPON ENTERING YOUR VEHICLE.
