Nick Gray Educates TRIO SSS-STEM Students About Challenges Facing First Gen Students



On Tuesday, August 28 TRIO students were invited to meet Nick Gray and learn about his life and his experiences navigating financial aid at a private university. Gray, who is currently the Programs Manager of the Water Education Foundation's events team, spent 15 years involved in formal and informal science education as a Middle School science teacher and as the education director of a science museum. He has also been involved with regional science communication organizations, including Capitol Science Communicators. As a first generation college student, Gray was able to offer insights on choosing a university, finding a major, management of student loans, and life after college. One TRIO student said, "I learned how to be responsible with loans, and how they can get dangerous really fast." Another noted, "It is okay to not be sure what I really want to do because I have resources to help me figure it out."

The TRIO Student Support Services (SSS)-STEM Program is a federally funded program through the Department of Education. Solano received TRIO SSS-STEM grant funding in 2015. The Program aims to support students in STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics) fields who are primarily first-generation and/or low income or who have a documented disability. Eligible program participants must be enrolled at Solano, cannot yet have an associate's degree or higher, and must meet the residency requirements for federal financial aid. Constitution Day Event

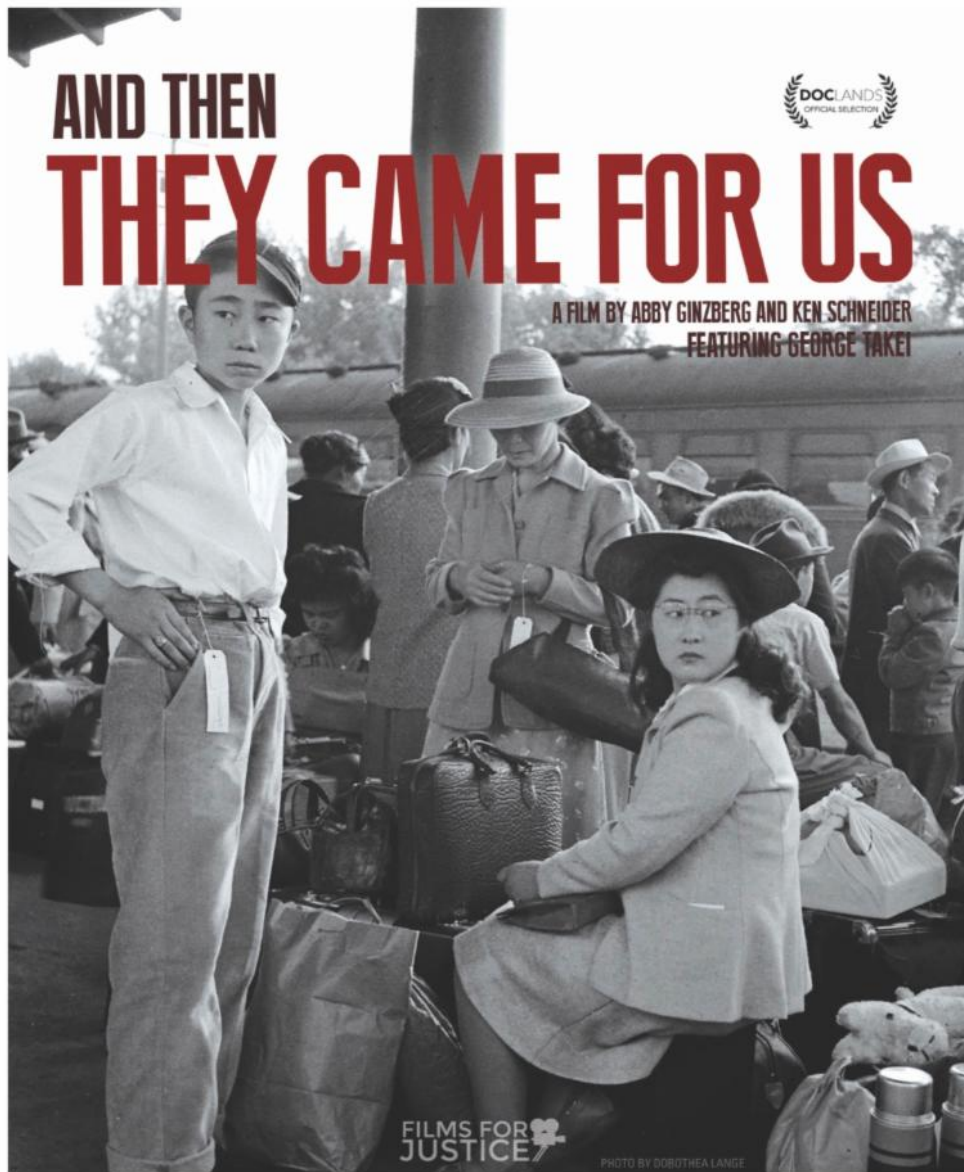

The AAMP was designed to give student-athletes resources for adjusting and succeeding at Solano College, and the mentors include Nikki Gentile (softball), Dustin Aubert (men's basketball), Robby Rogers (baseball), and Taryn Sigl (softball).

The mentors meet one-on-one with student-athletes to assist with the challenges of academics as a student-athlete, and they help student-athletes find college resources to assist with financial aid, how to buy books, time management and planning leadership qualities in the classroom,

Women's Soccer Recap: Last Tuesday, Freshman **Shelby Nichols** netted the game-tying goal in the final minute to lead the Falcons to a 1-1 draw with Ohlone on Tuesday afternoon. The Renegades took the early lead in the 26th minute and looked to hold on before freshman **Karla Cardinal** fed Nichols to stifle the lead. Freshman **Kirstyn Gottschall** tallied eight saves in the goal for the Falcons.

Volleyball Recap: Freshman **Kailyn Kaiser** served 54 errorless attempts with three aces in the Falcon volleyball team's split in the annual Falcon Classic on Wednesday evening. Solano defeated Diablo Valley in straight sets (26-24, 25-17, 25-6) before dropping a five-set heartbreaker to Butte (24-26, 25-15, 25-16, 26-28, 5-15).

Kaiser added 13 digs in the team's loss to the Roadrunners.

Sophomore middle blocker **Destiny Greenwood** paced the Falcons on both sides of the ball at the net against Diablo Valley with 17 kills and six blocks. Sophomore setter **Mia Pimentel** directed the offense with 62 assists on the day, adding eight aces against Butte. Solano (3-3) heads on the road to the Delta Classic.

In Friday's Delta Classic volleyball tournament, the Solano Community College Falcons split a pair of matches, falling 3-0 (25-20, 25-11, 25-19) to Gavilan before bouncing back with a 3-1 decision over Shasta. [Read More.](#)
