Humboldt State is a public institution and part of the 23-campus California State University system. With full-time undergraduate tuition of just \$7,863 annually, we're one of the best higher education values in the nation. We were founded as a teacher's college in 1913. Over the last century, we have grown from an institution focused solely on teacher education to an accredited university with extensive research facilities. There have been plenty of name changes over the years: We have been called Humboldt State Normal School, Humboldt State Teacher's College, Humboldt State College, CSU Humboldt and, since 1974, Humboldt State University.
